
This guide is intended to get you started with a **typical configuration** for the IBM Informix JDBC Driver.



Product overview

The IBM® Informix® JDBC Driver lets Java programmers access Informix databases from within Java applications or applets. Programmers can create client applications that use JDBC to connect to an Informix query, and retrieve data from a database or column, handle errors, and write UDRs. The IBM Informix JDBC Driver is compatible with the JavaSoft JDBC specifications. Informix JDBC Driver maps standard Java data types and IBM Informix data types.

The following diagram provides an overview of the base architecture of Informix and the Informix JDBC Driver.



1 Step 1: Access your software



Download the IBM Informix JDBC Driver Version 3.70 installation package from IBM (http://www.ibm.com/software/data/informix/tools/jdbc) or install the product from the IBM Informix JDBC Driver product CD provided in the installation media.

The installation package includes:

- IBM Informix JDBC Driver Version 3.70

Step 3: Install the Informix JDBC Driver



Prerequisite: You must be running JDK 1.6 or later.

Use the following instructions to install the Informix JDBC Driver:

1. Go to the directory where the installation files are located and run one of the following commands:

For graphical mode

java -jar dir/setup.jar install -i gui

For console mode

java -jar dir/setup.jar install -i console

where *dir* is the location of the setup. jar file.

- 2. Confirm the location of the installation in the installation panels, and optionally modify the installation directory.
- 3. Complete the panels in the installation application and click **Finish** when done.
- 4. To check the version of the installed JDBC driver, run the following command:

```
java -cp jdbcinstalldir\lib\ifxjdbc.jar com.informix.jdbc.Version
```

Where *jdbcinstalldir* is the path of the directory where the JDBC driver is installed.

The jdbcinstalldir/demo directory contains several JDBC demo programs. See the readme files in the demo directories for information about how to run the demo programs.
